EMISSIONS REDUCTION TARGETS

In order to progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets:

- We are looking at ways in which we can reduce our carbon emissions from Downstream
 Distribution and Commuting sources, such as the amount of waste produced on site, then
 needing to be transported away from site;
- Furthermore, we are also monitoring and benchmarking the utility consumption on site and setting informed targets on new sites with a view to reducing excessive use of water, electricity, and gas.
- The Casey "Green Team" being 20 employees from across the Casey group of companies
 tasked with identifying carbon reduction initiatives as well as other environmentally
 conscious initiatives will play a major part in our carbon reduction plan over the period to
 2050.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next 28 years to 0.00tCO2e by 2050. This is a reduction of 100%.



CARBON REDUCTION PROJECTS

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the 2020 baseline. The carbon emission reduction achieved by these schemes equate to 30 tCO2e, a 6.9% reduction against the 2020 baseline and the following measures are in effect at time of publishing;

- Adopt a hybrid working scheme, of two days working from home, with a view to reducing our carbon emissions from employee commuting.
- Switch our vehicles from diesel engine vehicles in an attempt to significantly reduce our carbon reduction emissions from our company vehicles
- Identify behavioural changes across the company to reduce energy usage, waste generation and water consumption
- The Green team will work to identify opportunities to reduce carbon emissions and will engage specialist consultants when appropriate to assist. Initiatives will review, for example, with the way we operate in our head office and also our on-site practices.



DECLARATION AND SIGN OFF

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with the requirements of PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.

Emissions have been reported and recorded in line with the published reporting standard1 for Carbon Reduction Plans and the GHG Reporting Protocol corporate standard and uses the appropriate Government emission conversion factors for greenhouse gas company reporting2.

Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions have been reported in accordance with SECR requirements, and the required subset of Scope 3 emissions have been reported in line with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Standard3 for business travel in employee owned vehicles. Other scope 3 emission data will be captured and reported upon in later carbon reduction plans.
